GOVERNMENT REGULATION

ARLA Propertymark has long campaigned for financial protection for tenants and landlords.

The Scottish Government listened to our concerns and passed the Letting Agent Code of Practice (Scotland) Regulations 2016. This means that from early 2018 all letting agents will need to register and be qualified.

ARLA Propertymark agents are independently regulated to ensure that they work to a higher standard than the law currently demands.
